Slips, trips, and falls	Players, coaches and members may slip in wet/dry conditions	Head coach of session will perform and document pitch inspection and ensure all members have moulded sole boots on.				
Equipment	Members may slip, trip, fall on equipment lying around in playing area.	Kit manager to ensure all equipment fit for purpose. Head coach to ensure no equipment lying around playing area.				
Visiting different venues (grounds and premises)	Members could slip, trip, fall if pitches not suitable	Team manager and coach to perform pitch inspection and ensure players have moulded sole boots on.				
Fire	If trapped, staff members suffer fatal injuries from smoke inhalation/burns.	Team manager to ensure venue has fire evacuation procedure and players are aware of this.				
Transportation	Members traveling by road to tournaments could be involved in a road traffic accident.	Team manager to ensure bus company has health and safety policy prior to booking. If traveling by car members must give consent to drive other players. Other players must give consent that they do so at their own risk and GLTRC not liable.
